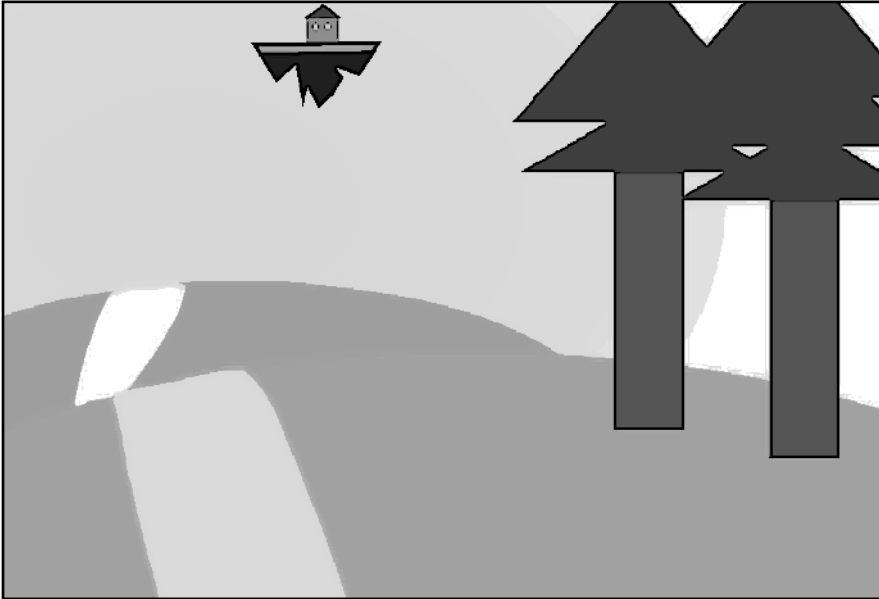

Do you see the house floating in the background? I'm glad I'm not them. Are you?

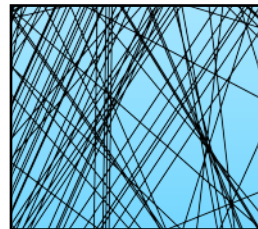
Kandonia suffering economic crisis

In conclusion, Kandonia is doomed, its president needs help, and it's a great depression out there now.

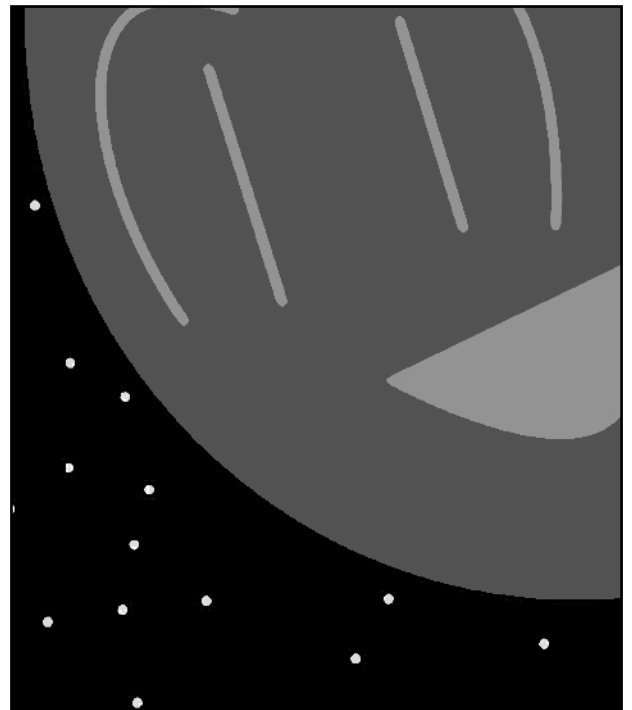

All about the Tubble- A most curious RDMZ weapon

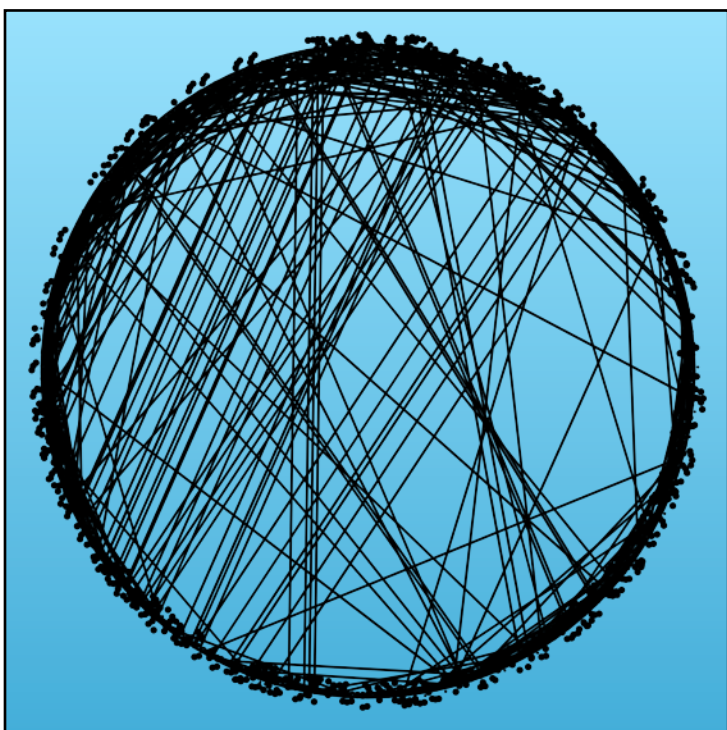
